The **console of the N-ZO 760** makes steering the boat particularly easy, and also provides practical interior space that can accommodate a WC.

 Entertainment areas have been enhanced. All N-ZO models have a spacious aft saloon that can seat a number of people and offers direct access to the aft bathing platform. has not been overlooked. The N-ZO is equipped with a new "Reverse & Sun" bow sunbathing system that allows an extensive sundeck to be created in a matter of seconds by simply unfolding the structure.
